



Guidelines for Grant application Student grant of up to £600

Thank you for requesting information about grants from the Fort Augustus and Glenmoriston Community Company. Please read the following notes before completing the application.

Aims of the grant programme

The broad aim of the FAGCC is to assist charities, individuals and community groups (with charitable aims) working to improve the quality of life and life chances in the Fort Augustus and Glenmoriston areas. Especially in circumstances where funding is particularly hard to find and where a grant can achieve significant impact in enabling groups/individuals to fulfill their own objectives.

Grants are made across a wide spectrum of social, welfare, heritage, educational and community development activities. We must emphasise that our funding is directed at those who are resident in the local community, and often initiated by, members of that local community.

The grant schemes are funded from the Company's resources received from its funding agreements with SSE Renewables and Renantis Renewables.

Description of student grant.

This grant scheme is designed to enable and motivate interest and involvement in Education, from Evening Classes to Degree level and beyond, by:

- (i) Assisting with travel expenses to allow students to return regularly to their home communities.
- (ii) Enhancing and enriching study beyond the secondary school curriculum.
- (iii) Engaging the public with lifelong learning.

Activities supported could include: the cost of travel, evening classes, short courses, Feis classes, tutors' costs for master classes, essential study materials.

Eligibility for student grant

Anyone resident in the Fort Augustus and Glenmoriston Community Council Boundary Area is eligible to apply for a grant.

All applicants are welcome to apply for the grant annually. There are a maximum of 4 grant applications per individual.

The amount for this grant will be £600, for those attending College or University full time. For those wishing to attend a part time course such as an evening class or one-off training course please supply details of the actual cost of the course you wish to attend, including quotations.

- There is no minimum/ maximum age requirement
- Only one grant may be applied for in a year up to a maximum of 4 years
- Grants must be spent within the academic year.
- Your application will be assessed and more information may be requested.

If you are applying for a part time or one-off training course please remember to send us evidence of the course fees.

Deadlines and decisions timetable

Grants will be assessed and approved by Directors. We may ask for more information as part of the assessment process. We aim to have your grant assessed and a decision made within 2 weeks of receipt.
